ABOUT K.V.N. NAIK SHIKSHAN PRASARAK SANSTHS

K.V.N. Naik Shikshan Prasarak Sanstha is a leading educational institution in Maharashtra. It was founded and named after the great visionary Krantiveer Vasantao Narayanrao Naik, who actively participated in freedom Struggle of India and was known as “Krantiveer”. He was born in 1912 at a village Manmad, Taluka-Nandgaon in Nashik District. All his life he remained a revolutionary and was fully devoted to social cause. He was convicted in a political trial first in the year 1940. After release from jail he actively participated in 'Quit India Movement' (१९४२) under the leadership of Father of our nation, Mahatma Gandhi.

In memory of this late revolutionary, the present institution K.V.N. Naik Shikshan Prasarak Sanstha was established in 1921 to provide education to the underprivileged and socially and economically weaker sections of society. Even before that accommodation facility with the name 'Dongare Vastigruha' was started in 1920 with the support of great Social Reformer Rajarshi Shahu Maharaj of Kolhapur Province. Initially, the Institution provided hostel facility to the students belonging to the backward categories who came from rural areas. The Institution has now 60 educational units and more than 25000 students are getting education. including primary, secondary, Jr. colleges & ITI.

The institution entered in the field of Technical education in 2011 by opening an Engineering college and Polytechnic college and in 2019 by opening Pharmacy college. (D. Pharm & B. Pharm) Presently we run 2 senior colleges in the district.

ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Kr. V. N. Naik Shikshan Prasarak Sanstha's Arts, Commerce and Science College started in June 1998 with barely 70 students. Since then it has surprised all by its quantitative and qualitative growth in last 20 years. At present around 5000 students are studying in various programmes and courses in the Institution. It has been the policy of the Institution over the years that the poorest of the poor are not deprived of the opportunity of higher education :The motto of our institution is 'Duritanche timir javo' which means, “Let the Darkness of Ignorance in the life of the downtrodden Disappear...” Being at the centre of the city, it is convenient for the students from all parts of the city to commute to the college easily.

We have been constantly striving to bring in improvements both on academic and administrative levels. The number of student has been increasing over the years and the success rate has satisfactorily improved every year. A number of programmes have been introduced during the last 21 years so that students are given more opportunities to opt for the courses of their choice. The teachers with essential qualifications have been recruited which has definitely helped to upgrade the academic standards of the institution. As a result of our conscious efforts and teamwork we have also got the status of a college with permanent affiliation in 2011. In 2012 the UGC Granted 12 (F), 2B Status to the College. This has helped the institution to improve the physical facilities and research activities of the departments which ultimately benefit the student community. The College got reaccredited in April 2015 by NAAC and obtained 'B' Grade.

STUDENT SUPPORT FACILITIES

Laboratories : The college has spacious and well equipped laboratories for all science departments and the language lab for English department. All the laboratories are well equipped. Physics lab includes material science research lab, Double beam UV spectrophotometer, pyrolysis system, and energy lab.

Library: The college has well equipped library. It has a rich collection of reference books, periodicals, encyclopedia, dictionaries and research journals. The separate reading hall is available for the students from early morning to evening.

Gymkhana: College has a large playground and well equipped gymnasium for boys and girls. Various sports facilities are provided by the college. Students can make use of these facilities as per the rules and regulations of the college. Physical Training (PT) is compulsory for first year students.

National Service Scheme : The college has an N.S.S. unit of 200 students. Annual special camp is organized by the N.S.S. unit. The program inculcates leadership qualities, social awareness, soft skills and social responsibilities, eradication of superstitions and social issues. N.S.S. provides a good opportunity for personality development.

Magazine: Magazine is a good platform for the development of student's creativity through writing short stories, poems, articles on current topics. The magazine is published annually.

Lecture Series and Remedial Lectures: Lecture series is one of the special features of every department. In this program eminent experts in respective subjects are invited to deliver a lecture on specific topic. Remedial lectures are arranged for slow learners and those who need extra academic support. The difficult and important concepts are discussed in this lectures.

Competitive exam Cell : The college has motivated the students for planning and to appear for different competitive exams.

Counseling Cell The department of Psychology provides psychological counseling for the students. Which includes psychological testing and psychological counseling, career guidance.

Vasant Scholarship : the Scholarship has been Introduced by our institute from 2019. The students securing top rank in their respective classes are given away this scholarship. The nature is 1000 rupees with a merit certificate.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1) An application for admission to the college will have to be made on line on college website by all students (including those who were in this college in the previous year)
Website : www.kvnnashik.vriddhionline.com
- 2) Students passing XII or any other equivalent examination are eligible for admission to the first year of Arts, Commerce, Science, BBA, BCA and Computer Science.
- 3) Students seeking admission to the first year will have to apply for the university eligibility certificate and will have to pay the necessary fees.
- 4) Students from any other college affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University will have to produce Transference Certificate. They will apply for T.C. in the given form at the time of admission.
- 5) Students getting admission from any other university will have to pay Rs.500/- for eligibility equivalence. They will also have to produce the following documents.
(Two copies each)

a) Migration certificate	b) Passing Certificate
c) Transference Certificate	d) Statement of Marks
e) Character Certificate	f) Two Passport size Photos

Students will be given provisional admission. The admission will be confirmed on receipt of Eligibility Certificate from Savitribai Phule Pune University.
- 6) Every student seeking admission to the first year will have to undergo medical checkup by a Medical Officer authorised by the college. His/Her application form for Eligibility Certificate will be sent to the university only after the medical certificate is produced.
- 7) Students seeking admission to the college will have to submit duly filled in admission form along with necessary fees on or before the stipulated date. Following documents must be produced along with the application form.
 - a) **Statement of marks (Attested true copy)**
 - b) **School Leaving Certificate OR T.C. (Original + Two attested true copies)**
 - c) **Other necessary certificates.**
 - d) **If applying for any scholarship/Concession of fees the students are expected to fill in prescribed forms and submit them along with necessary certificates.**
- 8) Students after taking admission must immediately procure the 'I' card with the signature of the Principal.
- 9) It is obligatory for the students to carry the 'I' card and admission receipt while on College Campus.
- 10) There will be term-end examination in Oct./Nov. for all the classes. For semester pattern, exam will be held as per university schedule.
- 11) Refund of fees after cancellation of Admission.
 - a) If admission is cancelled before the concerned course starts, only processing fees shall be deducted.
 - b) If an admission is cancelled after the concerned course starts, following scheme will be adopted for refund of total fees.

► **Central government scholarship for SC/ST/NT students :**

For the students belonging to Govt. notified SC/ST/NT categories like Mahar, Mang, Chambhar, dhor, Bhil, Mahadev Koli, Gond, Phase Pardhi etc. This Scholarship is given by the Director, Social Welfare Department of Govt. of Maharashtra. If a student getting this scholarship fails in the examination, she/he is not eligible for it. students eligible for the scholarship should take application forms at the time of admission and submit the duly filled in form to the college office.

► **Krantijyoti Savitrimata Phule Scholarship:**

This scholarship is given to the girl students only who have more than 50% of marks and have an annual income of below 75,000/- a student can avail this scholarship only once in her academic career. Such a student must not avail any other scholarship to be eligible for this scholarship.

Concession in fee for the freedom-fighter wards :

Application to be sent to Zilla Parishad office.

Concession in fees :

College gives all concessions in fees as directed by the government. Students who fulfill the necessary conditions, both educational economical are given concession in fees. It is the responsibility of the students to fill necessary forms within due dates, to secure acknowledgment and to preserve it for the years.

Rajarshi Shahu Maharaj Scholarship :

The concession is for those, whose parent's income is less than Rs.1,00,000/- The prescribed forms are made available in college office. Students can take forms from the office before 10th July.

The duly filled forms must reach the zilla parishad office before 15th July, through college. Following documents must be, attached to the form.

- i) Income certificate.
- ii) Affidavit of the parents (for rural areas : population upto 10,000)
- iii) Income certificate attested by Z.P. member, Gazetted Officer.
- iv) For students from urban areas (Population more than 10,000) the income certificate must be issued either by gazetted officer or Executive Magistrate or Tahsildar.

► **Concession in Fees for Secondary Teacher's Wards :**

This concession is for the students whose parents are secondary teachers either with S.S.C., D.Ed., or STC. Application should be submitted to college before 15th July.

► **Accident Insurance Policy :**

This is for all students admitted to all branches at the KVNNSPS. In case of an accident the policy holder will get compensation from the insurance company.

► **N.B. :**

Circulars & Concession regarding all above scholarships & concessions in fees are displayed on the notice boards. Students must read them for information. It is important that the students should read the notice board regularly.

Govt. orders/resolutions regarding scholarships shall be binding on all the students.

Students code of conduct

(Discipline and Attendance)

- 1) Each student should behave sincerely in the college. He / She should behave politely with the teachers, non-teaching staff members, and the staff in the library & with the co-students. If the students have any problem they should meet the principal or the vice-principal of the college.
- 2) Uniform (Dress code) and Identity Card is compulsory for each student in college campus.
- 3) Students should have park their vehicles in the place allotted to them.
- 4) Students should not wander in the college campus by bunking the classes and practicals.
- 5) Smoking, drinking and chewing 'gutkha' is strictly prohibited in the college campus.
- 6) Chewing tobacco & beetle leaf and throwing clutter in the college campus is strictly prohibited.
- 7) Students should not click photographs in the college campus & avoid the use of cell phone strictly.
- 8) Students are prohibited from bringing any such weapons in the college which would physically harm others.
- 9) Students are strictly prohibited to scribble anything on the walls of the classroom & of the toilet. If such a thing happens students will be severely punished.
- 10) Student should not damage the benches, tables, chairs, fans & lights in the classroom as well as the things in the campus. If such a thing happens student will be severely punished & compensation should be taken from them.
- 11) Students are strictly prohibited from making noise in the college campus communicating in the reading room and standing in the porch of the college.
- 12) The rules of the office and the library are mandatory for each student.
- 13) Students should not organize picnic on their own without the permission of the Principal and the Vice Principal.
- 14) If the students have any prejudices about the college he/she should give complaint to the Principal and should not give any complaint, on their own to the Newspaper and media.
- 15) No student should participate in any activity against the college, and society and should avoid caste and religion based unfair activities.

- 16) Students should participate in the sports, cultural and other extra-curricular activities and co-operate for good things.
- 17) At the time of examination electronics devices are strictly prohibited. Copying in the examination and using other unfair means will be treated as an offence and necessary action will be taken on the student.
- 18) The original certificates given to the college by the students will not be returned to the students'. The students should keep the attested copies of them before taking admission.
- 19) Action will be taken against students if it's found that they have made changes in any document on their own.
- 20) Students will not be allowed to found any board or associations without the permission of the principal.
- 21) It is the right of the Principal to allow or forbid the students from appearing in the examination who remain absent for lectures, internal tests, Term-End Examination and behave badly in the college.
- 22) Students should take admission in the college by filling in the form given by the college only.
- 23) Each student will be given an Identity card by the college. Student should stick a passport size photograph on it. He should show it if asked by the teachers, officers and administrative staff.
- 24) Students will be enrolled in the Second semester only if their behavior in the First semester is good.
- 25) Students should note that they have to take new admission every year.
- 26) Students should take the receipts of the fees paid from time to time from the concerned clerk. The fees once paid will not be returned.
- 27) Every student must complete average attendance of 80% in each semester. Students having low attendance will not be allowed to fill the examination form.
- 28) Students should strictly adhere to all the instructions written on the college Notice Board. Otherwise the student himself will be responsible for the loss.
- 29) Roaming in the college campus during the lecture time or behaving improperly will be treated as an offence.
- 30) Students should not bring radio, camera or cell-phone in the college.

- 31) Bringing a dummy person as a parent in the college is an offence.
- 32) The Principal has the right to give admission or cancel it at any moment without giving any reason.
- 33) Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college premises and outside. Students indulging in it will be punished as per circular “UGC Regulation No.f-18/2006 (CPPII) 4th March 2008 No.170. Such students will be expelled from the college. Legal action will be taken against them.
- 34) Students will not be allowed to change the faculty for any cause.
- 35) Nobody should meet the Student directly and they should enquire in the office before doing so.
- 36) It is the right of the Principal to occasionally organize or not to organize the Annual Social Gathering and the Annual Prize Distribution Ceremony in the college.
- 37) The students should themselves be present for taking the required certificates, Hall-Ticket, mark-sheet, L.C./T.C. in the college.
- 38) If a student does not submit the required documents in the college, he /she will be responsible for his/her loss.
- 39) Dress code is compulsory for students of Senior College according to the order of the institution. Students should strictly follow all the above rules as well as any other rules made by the college from time to time.

▪ **DISCIPLINE –**

- ✓ The student must observe and strictly follow the disciplinary rules and regulations of the Institute.
- ✓ The student should follow the academic calendar as per the instructions of Head of the Department.
- ✓ Any act of indiscipline or misbehavior by any student will attract severe punishment.
- ✓ Damage to Institute & campus property due to negligence/lack of care would attract punishment and compensation for loss caused.
- ✓ Students shall only use the waste bins for disposing waste materials in classrooms, hostels and offices to make the college campus free from plastic and other litter.

- ✓ Students have to park their vehicles in parking zone only. Any student found breaking the rule will be punished. Students are strictly prohibited to bring and park four wheeler ie cars in the campus of the institute.
- ✓ No person shall be invited to address or entertain the students of the college, without the prior written permission of college authorities.
- ✓ Students are prohibited from indulging in anti-institutional, anti-national, antisocial, communal, immoral or political expressions and activities within the Campus and hostels. Disciplinary action will be initiated against students indulging into eve teasing, molestation, ragging, harassment, bullying and untoward incidents.
- ✓ All Educational tours or Industrial visits shall be accompanied by the faculty members after obtaining necessary undertaking from the Parents o / Guardian of the students' and with the written consent of the management
- ✓ Unauthorized entry of outsiders into the campus as well as hostels is strictly prohibited. Without specific permission of the authorities, students shall not bring outsiders to the College or hostels.
- ✓ Any case of criminal activity or violation of law and order in the College Campus will be reported to the police.

▪ **I-CARD -**

- ✓ Every student must carry with him / her college and campus I-card every day while attending lectures and appearing for various examinations. The student should take his / her Identity Card and Library Card for Home Lending, from the Library at the beginning of the year.
- ✓ I-Card will be available a week after he / she produces his / her Identity Card size photographs along with Admission Receipt.
- ✓ The student should collect his / her I- Card within 15 days from the date of admission.
- ✓ The student should carry identity card with him / her regularly and the identity card should be produced when demanded by the authorized persons of the Institute.
- ✓ At the time of issuing a book, the Identity Card must be presented along

with the Library card. Without I- Card the reader may be refused the use of the Home Lending facility.

- ✓ If student has lost library card or I-card, it should be reported immediately to the coordinator / HOD and the librarian with an application.

▪ **HUMAN VALUES -**

- ✓ Be scrupulously honest in all academic activities and with all the stakeholders of the institute.
- ✓ Be attentive, fair and cooperative to your teachers and peers on various academic and non academic activities.
- ✓ Believe in loving, sharing and caring.

▪ **MOBILE PHONE -**

- ✓ The student should switch off their mobile phones while in the classroom, Laboratory, Library etc. as per notification.
- ✓ Mobile phone is strictly prohibited in the exam hall during the examination. Loss or theft of mobiles, modern means of communications, valuables and other belongings are at students' risk.

▪ **ATTENDANCE -**

- ✓ Student should be regular in attendance for all sessions during the day.
- ✓ Student should have at least 75% attendance in the Lectures of every subject and 100% overall performance.
- ✓ If the student is found irregular in attendance, disciplinary action will be taken. The student coming late shall not be allowed to enter the class.
- ✓ The student must report about the sickness to the Institute.
- ✓ On no account will students be allowed to remain absent for any mid-semester, term-end examination conducted by the Institute or continuous assessment conducted by faculty in class. The student will be entirely responsible for such absence. This may be detrimental to the overall performance and results of the student.
- ✓ Leave Travel Concession as per the rules and regulations of Indian

Railways and MSRTC will be allowed only for designated vacations, such concession forms will not be made available for travel in between vacations whatever be the reason.

- ✓ The student should complete all the Practicals and Term – work such as Journals, Assignments and Projects.

▪ **EXAMINATION -**

- ✓ Candidates must appear at the examination hall half an hour before the commencement of the examination.
- ✓ Mobile phone is strictly prohibited in the exam hall during the examination. If the mobile is seized by flying squad of Savitribai Phule Pune University, it will not be returned in any circumstance.
- ✓ Candidates should not communicate, transfer and pass on any cheating / copy / writing material to one another in any manner during the examination. A candidate is permitted to bring the following items to an exam: pen, pencil, and, if specifically permitted, non programmable calculators. ▪ **GENERAL -**

Loud/impolite talk/use of abusive language which offends the listener would be dealt with serious action. Expected to spend their free time in the Library/Reading Room.

MEASURES TO PREVENT RAGGING IN EDUCATIONAL

With reference to the order from Director, Higher Education, Maharashtra State the Board of Students' Welfare issued a circular on 6th January, 2009 to all affiliated colleges and\ recognized institutes of University of Pune to implement the measures suggested to prevent ragging in educational institute.

The Principals of affiliated colleges and Heads of recognized institutes were also requested to report to the University in this regards. Unfortunately very few colleges and institutes have made the compliance.

The Hon'ble. supreme Court of India in its Judgment and Order dated 11.02.2009 have suggested the mesures to prevent ragging in Educational institutes. All affiliated colleges and recognized Institutes are requested to follow these measures very strictly and submit the action taken report to this office on or before 25th May, 2009.

1. In the prospectus of the Higher Educational Institutions, it should be mentioned that if any incident of ragging, comes to the notice of the authority concerned the accused student will be given an opportunity to explain and if his explanation is not satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution. The number of causes of ragging and punishment given by the educational institution in the previous academic year should also be incorporated in the prospectus of Higher Educational Institutions.
2. To Constitute anti ragging committees and squads to check ragging and to publish names and telephone numbers of officials to be contacted by the students in case of ragging.
3. To Conduct counselling sessions and orientation courses for senior and fresh students.
4. All institutions should be whatever they can by ensuring punishment to the students found guilty of ragging, giving wide publicity to such punishments to act as a deterrent, strict enforcement of the various measures for preventing ragging.
5. To incorporate in admission notices/advertisements, appropriate messages regarding zero tolerance 1 towards ragging.
6. To undertake audio-video campaign at the commencement of the new academic session to prevent ragging.
7. To make efforts to publicize and sensitize students regarding the menace of ragging.
8. To generate awareness amongst students through student unions about the bad effects of ragging.
9. In appropriate cases, if the authorities are prima facie satisfied about the errant act of any student they can, pending final decision, suspend the student from the institutions and hostel, if any and given opportunity to him to have his say. The Police shall be informed immediately and criminal law be set into motion.
10. If it is found that any educational institution is trying to shield the errant students its grant-in aid should be reduced and in serious cases, should be denied.

Sexual Harassment / Vishakha Samiti

Sexual Harassment Means :

1. An unwanted conduct with sexual understones if it occurs or which is persistent and which demeans, humiliates or creates a hostile and intimidating environment or is calculated to induce submission by actual or threatened adverse consequences and includes any one of more of or all of the following unwelcome acts or behaviour (whether directly or by implication) such as -
 - a. Any unwelcome physical, verbal or nonverbal conduct of sexual nature.
 - b. Demand or request for sexual favours
 - c. Making Sexually colored remarks
 - d. Physical contact and advances or
 - e. Showing pornography.
2. Any one (or more than one or all) of the following circumstances, if it occurs or is present in relation -
 - a. Implied or explicit promise of preferential treatment as quid pro quo for sexual favours
 - b. Implied or explicit threat of detrimental treatment in the conduct of work and about the present or future status of the person concerned.
 - c. Creating an intimidating offensive or hostile learning environment.
 - d. Humiliating treatment likely to affect the health, safely dignity or physical, integrity of the person concerned.

Process of making complaints of sexual harrasment :

An aggrieved person is required to submit a written complaint to the 'Sexual Harrassment Committee' within three months from the date of incident. Provided that where such complaint cannot be made in writing, the presiding officer or any member of the 'Sexual Harrasment Committee' shall render all reasonable assistance to the person for making the complaint in writing.

Friends, relatives, colleagues, co-student, psychologist or any other associate of the victim may file the complaint in situation where the aggrieved person is unable to make a complaint on account of physical or mental in capacity or death.
